Consultant to the Executive Office of the President since 1965, Dr. Heller is kept busy traveling back and forth between the University of Minnesota and Washington, D.C. He served as chairman of the President's Council of Economic Advisers from 1961-64 and was the Godkin Lecturer at Harvard University last year. He has advised the government on numerous economic problems including Internal Finance for the Military Government in Germany and the Mission on German Fiscal Problems. He has also served as tax adviser to King Hussein and consultant to the United Nations. His most recent publication is "New Dimensions of Political Economy."

### LAWRENCE SENESH

Ten years ago Professor Senesh was the first American educator to be appointed to a chair in Economic Education by any college or university. He is currently teaching and conducting research projects for the Carnegie Corporation on Organic Curriculum. He promoted the fundamental ideas of economics at every grade level with increasing depth and complexity as the child's maturity increases and is author of "Our Working World," social studies curriculum published by SRA.

### ROMAN F. WARMKE



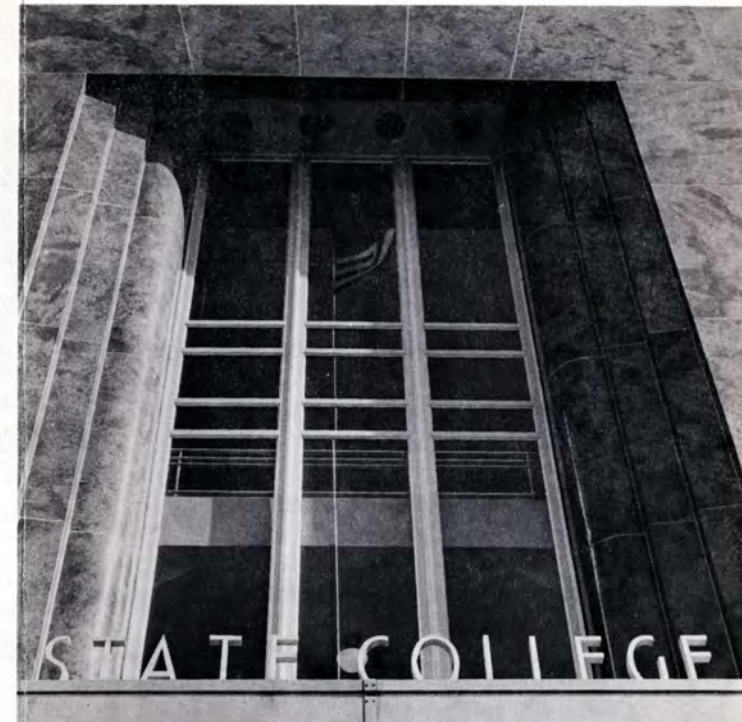
Executive Director, Ohio State Council
