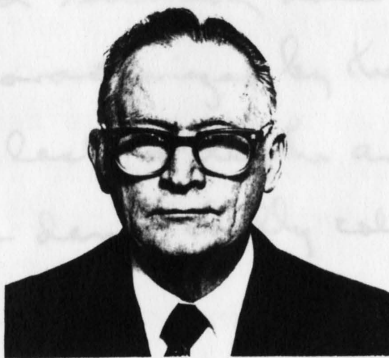
We will think of you after you're gone. We wish you well, and we look forward to greeting most of you on campus when we all return in the fall. Take care.
