ANDERSON, ALBIN

FILE NO. B-20

Albin Anderson was born July 18, 1875, in Tjorn, Sweden, the son of Andrew and Johanna (Helgeson) Anderson. He was reared to agricultural pursuits on his father's farm, passed thru the district school and finished his education at an Academy.

In 1895 Albin came to the United States. On his arrival he went to Barre, Vermont where he secured employment in a granite quarry. In 1898 Albin came to Perham, Minnesota where he was employed in a stone quarry until 1903. In that year he came to Saint Cloud. Here Albin organized the Black Diamond Granite Company with Charles Smith and Julius Lauer as partners. In 1916 this firm consolidated with the Pioneer Granite Company and successfully operated until 1924 when it was purchased by the North Star Granite Corporation. Albin at that time accepted a position as sexton at the North Star Cemetery where he has since continued.

In May 1903 Albin married Anna Maria Johnson at Perham, Minnesota. Anna Marie Johnson was born December 11, 1878 at Perham, Minnesota.

To Albin and Anna Maria (Johnson) Anderson have been born seven children. They are in order of birth Rose E. is married to Edwin C. Suess, they reside in St. Cloud. Walter T. lives in Port Arthur, Texas. Signe Delphine is the wife of Robert Dahl of St. Cloud. Clara A. is married to William H. Marshall of St. Cloud. Marian is the wife of Berger Tinglow, of St. Cloud. Glenn R. and Wallace L. make their home with their parents.

Albin and Anna Maria (Johnson) Anderson live at the family residence 610-7th avenue north.
