ANDERSON, ALFRED J.

Alfred J. Anderson was born in Varmland, Sweden, November 12, 1854. As a youth Alfred attended such schools as the district afforded. Upon the completion of his education he was employed in a jewelery store as an apprentice watch maker. In 1874 Alfred was given employment in a large watch factory in Stockholm, Sweden. Here he met and married Augusta Johnson. Augusta was born March 31, 1861 in Varmland, Sweden. Shortly after Alfred and Augusta (Johnson) Anderson came to the United States. After three months stay in New York City they came to St. Cloud. Here Alfred opened a jewelery store which he operated until 1899. He then returned to Sweden. Augusta (Johnson) Anderson continued her residence here. Alfred and Augusta (Johnson) Anderson were the parents of one daughter. Ingyard she is married to Hubert Bailey of Saint Cloud.

Mrs. Augusta (Johnson) Anderson makes her home with her daughter, Ingyard, at 412-5th Avenue South. Alfred J. Anderson died March 18, 1934 in Sweden.
