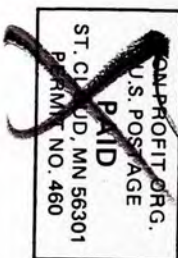
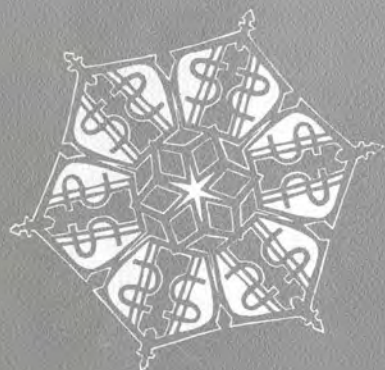

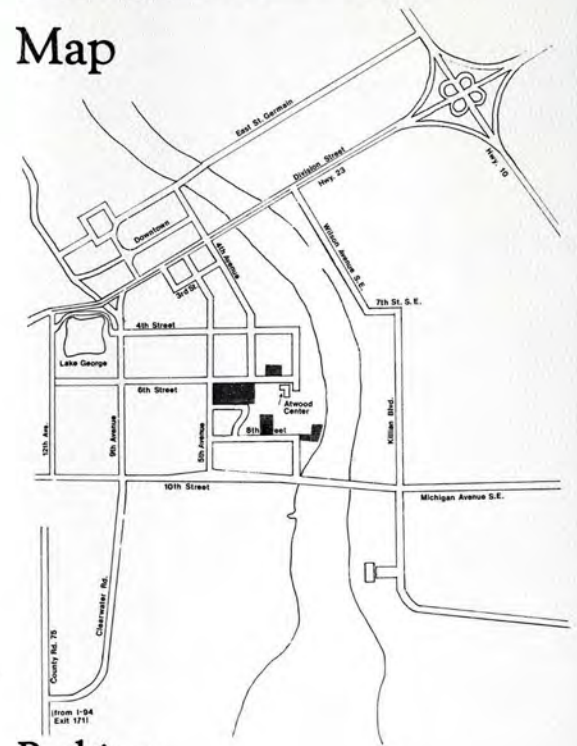

## Keynoter



**Martin Feldstein** is George F. Baker Professor of Economics, Harvard University, and President of the National Bureau of Economic Research. The National Bureau is a private, nonprofit research organization that has specialized in producing objective studies of the American

economy for 65 years. Dr. Feldstein's own research has focused on the problems of the national economy and on the economics of the public sector.

Feldstein served as Chairman of the President's Council of Economic Advisors, 1982-84. He received the John Bates Clark Medal of the American Economic Association in 1977. He was elected a Fellow of the Econometric Society in 1970 and a Fellow of the National Association of Business Economists in 1980.

Feldstein is a member of the Board of Contributors of *The Wall Street Journal* and the Board of Economists for *Time*. He, with his wife Kathleen, also an economist, is a syndicated columnist for *The Washington Post* and *The Los Angeles Times*.

Educated at Harvard and Oxford Universities, Feldstein received his Ph.D. from the latter in 1967. He became a member of the Harvard economics department faculty in 1967.

## Featured Speaker



**Joseph A. Pechman** is a Senior Fellow at the Brookings Institution in Washington, D.C. He was Director of the Economic Studies program at Brookings from 1962 to 1983. Brookings is devoted to research on public policy issues.

Dr. Pechman is recognized as one of the nation's foremost tax economists. He has served as an advisor to presidents and presidential candidates and has been a consultant to many government agencies and congressional offices over the past 30 years. He is one of the nation's leading proponents of comprehensive tax reform. He has published numerous books and articles on income distribution, social security, the federal tax system, and welfare reforms.

Pechman has served as President of the American Finance Association and the Eastern Economic Association, and Vice President of the American Economic Association. He was elected a Fellow of the American Academy of Arts and Sciences in 1973. He was a member of the Board of Economists for *Time* for ten years.

Pechman received his Ph.D. from the University of Wisconsin in 1942. He joined Brookings in 1960.

## Luncheon Speaker



**Gary H. Stern** is President of the Federal Reserve Bank of Minneapolis. He is also a member of the Federal Open Market Committee, the principal body in the federal government responsible for establishing national money and credit policies.

Stern joined the Federal Reserve Bank of Minneapolis in 1982 as Senior Vice President and Director of Research. Before that, Mr. Stern was a partner in a New York-based economic consulting firm. He has also served on the faculties of Columbia University, Washington University, and New York University.

Stern is co-author of *In the Name of Money: A Professional's Guide to the Federal Reserve, Interest Rates and Money* and has authored numerous articles for economic journals. He serves on the board of directors of Minnesota Public Radio and the Minnesota Council on Economic Education.

Mr. Stern earned his Ph.D. in economics from Rice University, Houston.
