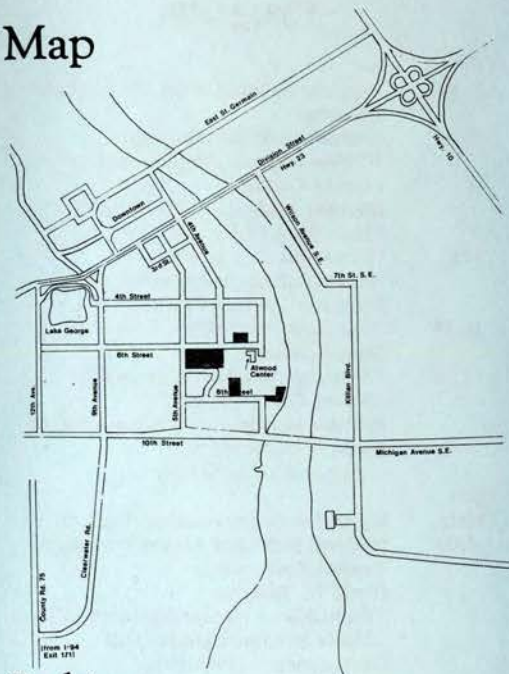

**Keynote Address:
"Economic Deregulation—
Accomplishments, Problems,
and Prospects"**

Alfred E. Kahn is the Robert Julius Thorne Professor of Political Economy at Cornell University and a Special Consultant to National Economic Research Associates. He was appointed by President Carter to serve as Advisor to the President on Inflation.

Kahn served as this Advisor from 1978-1980 and also served as Chairman to the Council on Wage and Price Stability. Additionally, he was on the Council of Economic Advisors to the President during 1955-57.

He received the Harry E. Salzberg 1986 Honorary Medallion for outstanding achievement in the field of transportation in April, 1986.

Kahn has researched and published extensively, and has provided testimony to a wide range of U.S. Congressional committees and Federal and State commissions.

Educated at New York University, the University of Missouri, and Yale University, Kahn received his Ph.D. from the latter in 1942. He became a member of the Cornell Economics Department in 1947.

The 1987-1988 academic year marks the 50th Anniversary of the College of Business. The Winter Institute was initiated through the College of Business--with pleasure, this 26th annual Winter Institute commemorates the College of Business 50th Anniversary.

James Ulland is the Senior Vice-President for Corporate Relations at First Bank System, Inc. in Minneapolis.

His responsibilities at First Bank System include communications, government relations, and the First Bank System Foundation.
