Cornie must stay with me Thursday night. All right? It'll be alot of fun! I can hardly wait. I shall expect them Thurs. evening and ~~it~~ ~~would~~ I hope you can get here before 10:00.

I'm going out to Edwards tonight for dinner and coming right back. They are anxious to see Daddy and so maybe we can drive out there Fri.

morning before we leave.

It's just pouring today and everyone is going around barefoot except me who has a sore throat again!

Eager as I am to get home, I hate to leave here so much it just hurts me. But there will be next fall.

Now that Econ. is over I'm not worried. Of course, my Chem. final makes the difference between a C and a D and I just can't get another D just when I think I'm getting 2 B's to pull up that D in Physics.
