BAKKO, OLE E.

Ole E. Bakko was born in Ness, Hollingdahl, Norway on March 22, 1867.

In 1888, in the spring, he came to America. For two or three years he worked for farmers in Northfolk and Belgrade.

On June 22, 1891, Ole Bakko married Barbara Halgiumson. They lived on a farm three miles west of Brooten. In 1901, they acquired a farm in Gilchrist township.

There were five children: Mrs. Carl Lingen of Starbuck; and Inga, Martin, Helma, and Helmer at home. Helma, born on August 11, 1893 and died on April 12, 1894.

Barbara (Halgrimson) Bakko was born on September 24, 1864, and died December 8, 1927.

Ole Bakko died May 26, 1928.
