BARRETT, BENJAMIN

Benjamin Barrett was born in Meigs county, Ohio, in 1830. He was brought up on a farm. In 1856 he came to Anoka county, Minnesota. He married Miss Mary H. Wiley, and in 1861, they moved to Maine Prairie, and located on a farm which he cultivated until he sold it in 1890, when he moved to Excelsior, Minnesota, where he now resides. In 1862, he enlisted in the first regiment of mounted rangers and operated on the frontiers against the Indians.
