BEIDLEMAN, GEORGE ERNEST

George Ernest Beidleman was born on September 1, 1862 at Cannon City, Minnesota the second son of Samuel and Charlotte (Carr) Beidleman. In 1866 he came to Sauk Centre with his parents. He attended school in Sauk Centre and later attended Coughen College or College farm then located in Bangar Township in Pope County north of Brooten.

On December 25, 1888, George E. Beidleman was united in marriage to Effie White, a daughter of James and Phebe (McCallum) White of the McCormick lake district.

For a time George E. Beidleman lived on a farm in Ashley township and later moved to Lyman Prairie. Besides operating a large farm George E. Beidelman had a cheese factory before creameries were so numerous. He retired from farming in 1926 and moved to Sauk Centre where he died on November 5, 1936.

The children of George E. and Effie (White) Beidleman are: Mrs. Seth Angle (Eva) of St. Paul, Minnesota; Mrs. Milo Cowl Thorpe (Alberta) of Driscoll, North Dakota; Clyde of Sauk Centre; Fay of Westport and Mrs. Maurice Adams (Edith) of Newberg, Oregon.

There are seventeen grandchildren and two great grandchildren.
