H. P. Bennett was born in Spencer, Massachusetts, in 1819, and when 12 years old he went to Chicopee, where he was engaged in making patterns for a foundry. In 1857 he came to Maine Prairie and bought a farm and carried it on until 1863 when he moved to St. Cloud, and opened a gun store and repair shop. In 1888 his wife died. He soon after sold out his store and retired to private life. He was one of the first collectors in the town and also held the office of Justice of the Peace several years.
