W. P. Bennett was born in Burns, New York, May 7th, 1825, and grew up a farmer. He graduated at a high school in Livingston county, N. Y. Mr. Bennett and Miss Mary J. Trembly were married in 1853, and in the fall of 1856 they came to Anoka, and in July of 1857 they came to Paynesville and located a claim and began improving it. They lived in the village until the fall of 1860 when they moved on to their claim. He was justice of the peace for many years and has held other town offices. He was assessor when severel townships were joined in one town called Verdale.
