## COURSE NUMBER CHANGES

The Department of Library and Audiovisual Education has changed some of its course numbers and dropped some courses from the bulletin. The change is as follows: 471 & 611 will be 471 571; 473 & 613 will be 473 573; 475 & 650 will be 475 575; 476 & 630 will be 476-576; 477 & 635 will be 477-577; 478 & 637 will be 478-578; and courses dropped are: 645, 648, 652, 653, 659, 664, and 666.

## RECENT CONFERENCES AND MEETINGS

Moorhead State College hosted the Media Education Conference on February 6 and 7, 1975 to discuss the direction of media education and certification requirements in Minnesota. Faculty from all colleges and universities offering programs in media education attended plus there were representatives from MASL, AVCAM, and the practicing public school media profession.

A meeting was held in St. Cloud of Region 6 AVCAM & MASL members on March 13, 1975 to discuss merger. By a vote of 56 to 1, the group moved to urge the AVCAM & MASL leadership to have a merger formulated by the fall of 1976 and if the merger is not started by then, the members present would withdraw membership from both organizations.

A media conference was held in Alexandria on January 29 for Region 3, 4, 5, & 6 of AVCAM & MASL. The program included a visit to an elementary school, centralized processing and computers in schools, periodicals and an equipment display. Mary Dalbotten and Robert Anderson explained state trends and State Department reorganization. Ed Payne and Kay Brinkman had a message from AVCAM & MASL. The conference also elected representatives from each region to MASL & AVCAM.
