Henry Block was born in Hanover, Germany, in 1812. He and Miss Johanna Ziegenbein were married in 1842. In 1856 he came to this country, stopping a few months in Wisconsin. He started with his family in an ox team and arrived near the north line of Fair Haven on the 15th of September. Here his wagon broke down, and he located his claim near there on Beaver Lake. He was accompanied by his wife and two sons, H. C. and Henry. His son H. C. now owns and operates this farm.
