BOOBAR, HENRY A.

Henry Boobar was born in Maine where the early days of his life were spent.

In the summer of 1855 Henry came to Minnesota. His wife and children, Oliver B. Emma, Charles and Evelyn joined him.

In August, 1860, Henry Boobar brought his family from Minneapolis in an ox-cart to Sauk Centre Township. He located about a mile from town on the Sauk River. He helped to build the Indian stockade in Sauk Centre.

Henry A. Boobar was married on November 18, 1846, to Phebe K. Kent-Bolton. After moving to Sauk Centre they build the first frame dwelling house here.

Henry A. and Phebe (Kent-Bolton) Boobar had five children: Oliver B., at one time at Postmaster in Sauk Centre died in 1923; Emma, Mrs. C. C. Tobey; Charles, Evelyn; and John J., who was born in Sauk Centre, was a librarian of the House of Washington, D. C. in 1907.

Henry A. Boobar was on the school board for many years.

Henry Boobar died in 1878 in Sauk Centre.

Phebe K. (Kent-Bolton) Boobar was born in South Dover, Maine, on May 31, 1821, and died on May 9, 1909. She is buried in the Oakland Cemetery in Sauk Centre.
