BREER, HERMAN B.

Herman B. Breer was born January 31, 1870 in St. Louis, Missouri, son of Henry and Regina (Lembeck) Breer.

Henry and Regina Breer were natives of Germany coming to America in 1865. The trip across the ocean took six weeks in a sailing vessel. Henry Breer was taught the brick laying trade and followed this trade during his life in this country.

In 1878 Henry Breer moved to Richmond, Stearns County coming by steamboat and lumber wagon. In this community Herman Breer completed his education. After receiving what education was available, Herman worked on the section, and then followed the bricklaying trade.

Henry Breer died February 24, 1901 and is buried at Richmond. Herman the subject of this biography is still living in Richmond.
