COOPER, JOHN

John Cooper, farmer and lumberman born in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, January 1, 1836; died in Riverside, California, January 8, 1907. He came to Minnesota in 1856; served in the Eighth Minnesota Regiment in the Indian and Civil wars. He afterward owned several farms near St. Cloud, and for twelve years engaged in the manufacture of lumber. During the last ten years of his life he spent his winters on his ranch in California.
