F. H. Dam was born in Enfield, Maine, in 1835. He took a claim on Maine Prairie, but spent much of his time for a number of years working at his trade in Minneapolis, afterwards establishing himself in business in St. Cloud. Since then, he has been so well known throughout the county that it is needless to add any thing regarding his life. During the fort life on Maine Prairie in 1862, his coolness, bravery and knowledge of military tactics, were of inestimable value to the settlers during those perilous times. He was one of the officers, and drove through to St. Paul and procured arms and amunition for those in the fort, when many brave men shrank from the dangerous undertaking.
