DANZL, MRS. MARGARET (REINERT)

Margaret Reinert was born in Avon Stearns County, Minnesota on March 24, 1877. She is the daughter of Michael and Louise (Prim) Reinert. Michael was born in Prussia about 1839, Louise was also born in Germany. John and Anna Reinert were the parents of Michael and the grandparents of Margaret. They settled in Avon before 1860.

Margaret was raised on her father's homestead near Avon. On August 31, 1897 she married Casper Danzl at St. Joseph, Minnesota. The ceremony was performed by Rev. Facher Lutger. Casper Danzl was born in Stearns County on July 16, 1868 son of Ferdinand and Katherine (Ebnet) Danzl.

The couple came to St. Cloud in 1901. Casper Danzl was employed by the Great Northern Railway Company as section foreman. His work took him all through Stearns County and Mrs. Danzl remarked that he often brought home deer and wild game birds.

Casper Danzl was employed by the railroad at the time of his death on August 28th, 1933. The funeral mass was said by his son Father Arthur Danzl at St. Mary's Church in St. Cloud. Burial was made in St. Joseph, Minnesota.

Margaret (Reinert) Danzl died suddenly on November 6, 1936 from a heart attack. Burial was made in St. Joseph.

Casper and Margaret (Reinert) Danzl had four children: Father Arthur, Mrs. Catherine Campbell, Lawrence and Marion.
