DAY, WM. H.

Wm. H. Day was born in the town of Cushing, Kennebec county, Maine, in 1821, and arrived in Fair Haven in 1856, remaining there four years. In 1860 he moved onto a farm in Maine Prairie. He was the first constable elected when the three towns were organized into one town. He was also a member of the Board of Supervisors. His son Eugene, was the first white child born in Fair Haven, which occurred in 1857. He tilled his farm for many years. In Maine he followed farming and lumbering. Mr. Day assisted in building the first house built on the Fair Haven town site in the fall of 1856.
