John Dilley was born in Ohio July 26, 1861 son of Joseph and Jennie (Campbell) Dilley.

John Dilley married Mary Robbins on January 4, 1881.

Mary (Robbins) Dilley was born at Sacketts Harbor, New York April 7, 1861.

After his marriage John Dilley engaged in farming in Rice county, Minnesota. In 1894 he moved to New London, Minnesota where he was engaged as a rural mail carrier. In 1905 John lived at Waite Park, Stearns county and then moved to Sandy Beach on Lake Koronis.

To John and Mary (Robbins) Dilley were born four children, Edward C. born May 12, 1882 deceased; March 4, 1883. Walter R. born September 7, 1886, deceased April 13, 1924. Joseph L. born February 26, 1889 and Arthur C. born April 19, 1892.

Mary (Robbins) Dilley died July 10, 1935.

On September 5, 1937 John Dilley married Milley (Pond) Ketchun at Spicer, Minnesota.

Milley (Pond) Dilley was born at Castle Rock, Minnesota on November 8, 1875. John Dilley and Milley (Pond) Dilley reside at Sandy Beach Lake Koronis.
