Joseph Friedl was born in Langdorf Austria, Germany. In the year 1880 he came to America with several other friends and at once came west to St. Paul, Minnesot where he found his first employment in a stone quarry and later employed by an ice concern.

On November 14, 1887 he married Mathilda Fisher at St. Paul, Minnesota. Mathilda Fisher was born March 13, 1885 in Bavaria, Germany the daughter of Joseph and Katherine (Urman) Fisher.

Joseph and Katherine (Urman) Fisher were born in Germany and were married there. Until the time of his death Joseph Fisher was employed as a foreman of a carpenter crew. After his death his widow and the daughter Mathilda came to America and made their home with a brother, who had migrated here several years before and resided at St. Paul. After several years in America, the mother also died and buried was made at St. Paul. In the year 1892 Joseph Friedl his wife and two children came to Albany where he purchased a tract of wild land three miles north of the village. Through hard work and good management Joseph Friedl soon transformed the wilderness into a modern dairy farm, and at the time of his death which occoured March 1, 1913 his lifes work was well done. After the death of Joseph Friedl, the farm was taken over by the son Max who operated it until 1920. In that year the widow disposed of the farm and purchased a home in the village of Albany. Mathilda (Fisher) Friedl despite her advanced age of 83 is still unusally active in mind and body. At present she makes her home with a daughter Mrs. Joseph Kulas. Joseph and Mathilda (Fisher) Friedl are the parents of five children. Mathilda born----- died at the age of seven years and ten months. Max born----married Mary Matros and they reside on a farm near New Munich, Minn. Mary, born-----was Sister Merceleta O. S. B. who died at St. Joseph, Minn. Rose---- born, is Mrs. Frank Marech and they reside on a farm near Elrosa, Minnesota.

Mathida born-----married Joseph Kulas and they reside at Albany

Mathilda, born-----married Joseph Kulas and they reside  
At Albany. M. Schaefer store.

There are also sixteen living grand children.
