Reinhart Gamradt was born February 23, 1853 in New Kugelwitz, Germany. He left his native land when fourteen years of age and sailed before the mast for twelve years making two complete trips around the world as a sailor. He quit the sea and was married to Henrietta Voss in 1883. Henrietta Voss was born in Germany October 3, 1858. Twelve children were born to this union. They are Emil; Emma; Albert; George; Rose; Max; Clara; Eda; Edward; Fred, who died at the age of three.

Reinhart Gamradt came to Sauk Centre when the mines closed at Republic, Michigan, where he had been a foreman for several years. He bought a homestead about three miles east of Sauk Centre where he cleared the land and erected suitable buildings and carried on general farming until his death.

Reinhart Gamradt was affiliated with the Lutheran Church. He served as clerk of the school board for a number of years and was also on the Sauk Lake Creamery board.

Reinhart Gamradt has twenty-six grandchildren and one great-grandchild, Donald Wayne Lambert.

Reinhart Gamradt died May 6, 1932. Funeral services were conducted from the Lutheran Church, Reverend Shumaker officiating. He was buried in Greenwood Cemetery Sauk Centre.
