GASPARD, JOHN

John Gaspard was born in Alsace-Lorraine, Germany on July 5, 1848. He grew to manhood in his native land coming to America and St. Cloud when he was about 30 years old. A few years later John Gaspard located in Sauk Centre where he was married to Barbara Gaspard a daughter of Mat Gaspard. She was born at St. Cloud, Minnesota, on October 26, 1867. In the spring of 1882 her parents moved to Padua, Raymond township and lived there until 1900 when they moved to Sauk Centre.

John and Barbara (Gaspard) Gaspard lived on a farm near Padua in Raymond township until 1903 when they moved to Sauk Centre.

John and Barbara (Gaspard) Gaspard were parents of seven children: Edward; Albert; Josephine of Sauk Centre; Frank of Devils Lake, North Dakota; Theodore, of Albany, Minnesota; John, of Long Beach, California; Verena of Lamoure, North Dakota.

Barbara (Gaspard) Gaspard died July 1, 1931 and John Gaspard died June 4, 1933.

The family were of the Catholic faith.
