GILMAN, CHARLES ANDREW

Charles Andrew Gilman, Lieutenant Governor, was born in Gilmanton, New Hampshire, February 9, 1833, came to Sauk Rapids, Minnesota, in 1855, and removed to St. Cloud in 1861. He was Receiver, and afterward Register of the United States land office at St. Cloud for several years, was a member of the State Senate in 1868 to 1869, and of the House in 1875 to 1879, being Speaker the last two years, was Lieutenant Governor, 1880 to 1887, and State Librarian, 1894 to 1899.
