GILMAN, DAVID

David Gilman, born in Saratoga county, New York, April 29, 1812; died in Watab, Minnesota, May, 1885. He came to Minnesota in 1848, being employed by the American Fur Company; settled the next year in Watab, Benton County, where he was sheriff four years; was representative in the territorial legislature in 1850, and a member of the constitutional convention 1857.
