GOETKER, HENRY

Henry Goetker, a pioneer of Luxemburg township, Stearns county, Minnesota, was born in Cincinnati, Ohio about the year 1846. There he received his early schooling, and grew to manhood. About 1866 Henry was married to Anna Rolling, also a native of Cincinnati, Ohio. One year later they went to Saint Paul, Minnesota, and from there they came by ox team to Luxemburg township, Stearns county where they settled on a homestead. Henry successfully operated this homestead until his death in 1916.

Henry and Anna (Rolling) Goetker were the parents of five children, Anna; Katherine; John; William; and Arthur, all the above being dead, but Katherine who married Harry Grimmer of Saint Cloud, Minnesota.
