HACKMANN, FREDRICK

Fredrick Hackmann, son of William and Angelia (Berheger)

Hackmann was born August 7, 1862, in Hanover, Germany.

In 1881 he came to this country. After landing in New York he came by train as far as Albany. From there he walked to Oak Station, Freeport, where he worked for a month. Then he came to Grove township, Stearns County where he worked on a farm for eight years. In the mean time his brother Henry went to Quincy, Illinois and Fredrick joined him at the end of five years. A year later Fredrick returned to Grove township, Stearns County where he engaged in agriculture until 1889 when he opened a saloon which he ran for twenty-seven years.

At one time there were quite a few Indians around Grove township, Stearns County, but the settlers never had any serious trouble with any of them.

Fredrick Hackmann has been prominent in the affairs of the community, and for eighteen years he was clerk of the school board.

Fredrick Hackmann was married in 1894 to Anna Schulte and they had four children; Henry, Louise, Ellenora and Rose (deceased).

On December 7, 1898 Anna (Schulte) Hackmann died, and is buried at Meire Grove.

Fredrick Hackmann married for the second time on February 5, 1901, to Mary Moore, and they had six children: Anna, Joseph, Julia, Aloys, William and Herbert. Joseph Hackmann drowned on June 9, 1921.

Fredrick Hackmann, the person who heads this biography, has lived in Meire Grove for the past fifty-six years.
