HAGEN, NICHOLAS

Nicholas Hagen was born February 18, 1863 in Germany, son of Mathew and Katherine (Lehnen) Hagen. In this family were eight children: Michael, Peter, Nicholas, Katherine, and Barbara, the names of the remaining three are unknown.

Nicholas received his schooling in Germany and when twenty-three years old, he came to America and settled in Cincinnati in 1886, remaining until 1897. In that year he came to New Munich, Stearns County, Minnesota, where he received work as a janitor in the Catholic Church.

In 1921 he came to St. Cloud, where he now lives in retirement.

June 5, 1886 he was married to Margaret Lakaf, who was born September 29, 1862 in Germany, daughter of Joseph and Mary(Breier) Lakaf. Margaret (Lakaf) Hagen came to America when she was twenty-three years old.

To Nicholas and Margaret (Lakaf) Hagen were born twelve children: Annie, born August 24, 1888; Elizabeth, born January 10, 1890; Katherine, who died when she was five years old; John, born June 27, 1894; William, born September 19, 1896; Bernard, deceased; Katherine, born July 25, 1900; Joseph, born October 10, 1902; Nicholas, born October 10, 1902; Mark, born April 17, 1905; Paul, born May 29, 1907. There are twenty grandchildren and six great grandchildren.
