HALVERSON, KITTLE

Kittle Halverson, a native of Norway, was born on the 15th of December, 1846. He came with his parents to the United States in 1848, locating near Whitewater, Wisconsin. From thence they removed to Lodi, Wisconsin, then to Winnebago where his father died, his mother having died four years prior to that time. In November, 1865, Mr. Halverson came to Minnesota and took a soldier's claim of one hundred and sixty acres in the township of North Fork. This privilege was obtained for two years' service rendered in Battery C, of the Second Wisconsin Heavy Artillery. He participated in the battle of Chattanooga, which was one of the most remarkable battles of the war, owing to the almost impregnable position held by the Confederate army upon a lofty mountain. Mr. Halverson has held office in the town since he attained the age of elective franchise, and is one of the most influential men in the town, in church and town affairs. He married Miss Geoline Anderson, on the 28th of November, 1870. They have five children living; Henry J., Nora A., Hannah J., Samuel A., and Clara J.
