HARMON, JESSE L.

Jesse Harmon was the son of Jacob Harmon, one of the early settlers in Pope county. Jesse was born in Duboiscounty, Indiana on March 1, 1852. At an early age he moved with his parents to Scott country, Missouri, where he was raised on a farm.

In July, 1877, he went to Fargo, North Dakota, and worked at the harness trade.

April, 1878, Jesse returned to Sauk Centre where he was employed as tradesman and foreman by William Scherffins, the well-known harness dealer.
