HARRISON, E. J.

E. J. Harrison was born December 25, 1848, in St. Clair county, Illinois. He lived here until 1859, when he came to Minneapolis.

In 1876, he came to Sauk Centre and became a partner of P. Lamb in the Mercantile business. In January, 1880, they sold out the business. E. J. Harrison then began business in the same line.

In August, 1874, E. J. Harrison married Mary E. Smith of Maine.
