HARRISON (FLYNN) BRIDGET

Bridget Flynn was born in May County, Ireland, on December 18, 1846. She came to America with her mother when she was about seven years old. They located in Manitoba, Canada.

They lived in Canada for twenty years. When they moved to Iowa they spent six months at Nashau and then moved to Marble Rock.

In September 1889, Bridget Flynn was married to Lovell Harrison at the Daughterty Parish house in Ward County, North Dakota. The Harrison's were of Catholic faith.

In 1892, they came to Sauk Centre. They lived in town for six months and then moved to a farm west of the town which they purchased and here made their home.

Bridget (Flynn) Harrison died September 22, 1933. She was a sister to Patrick Henry Flynn.
