HEYWOOD, WILLIAM

William Heywood came from Albion, Maine, in 1856, accompanied by his two sons William L. and Milton. Mr. Heywood was one of the collectors chosen in early times. He also held other important town offices. But in a few years was called to a better land, and peacefully passed over the dark river. His son, William L. Heywood, continued to operate the farm his father had taken. He was born in Maine in 1832. He takes a deep interest in town and school affairs, and has held the office of town supervisor and school clerk many years. His brother, Milton, moved to Minneapolis many years ago.
