HOFBAUER, NORBERT R. C.

Norbert Hofbauer, R. C. priest, born in Baumgarten, Bohemia, January 16, 1854; died at St. John's Abbey, Collegville, Minnesota; July 17, 1901. He came with his parents to the United States in 1866, and to Minnesota the next year; entered St. John's College in 1867; became a member of the Benedictine Order in 1873; was ordained a priest in 1877; was prior of St. John's Abbey, 1879 to 1889. He was prominent in the musical department of that institution, and established the commercial college of St. John's University.
