HOLDING, RANDOLPH

Randolph Holding, farmer, born in McHenry county, Illinois, July 27, 1844, came to Minnesota in 1861; served in the Eight Minnesota Regiment in the Civil War; settled in Holding township, Stearns county, in 1868, being the first white settler there. The township is named for him. In 1872 he was a representative in the legislature.
