William Hollenhorst was born in July, 1853 in Evansville, Indiana. He is the son of Frederick and Bernadine (Robbers) Hollenhorst.

Frederick, the father of William, was born in Germany in the year of 1823. He came to the United States in 1847 locating in Indiana working at the carpenter trade for nine years. He married Bernadine Robbers in 1851 and in 1856 came to Saint Cloud working at his trade until 1869. He then bought a farm on section fifteen and sixteen in Saint Cloud, there were three children Josephine, Bernadine, and William.

William sent to the public schools and when seventeen years of age he entered Saint John's University, then located in Saint Cloud.

William Hollenhorst married Anna Berger the 10th of July, 1882 at the Saint Mary's church in Saint Cloud, Minnesota. They had seven children, Mary, who died at the age of fourteen years; William Jr., married Anna Elenbecker of Cold Spring, they have eleven children and are now living on a farm in Sauk Rapids; John, married Josephine Mainz, they have ten children and live in Saint Cloud where John sells Insurance; Joe, is on a farm in Montana; August, married Mary Stather, they have five children and live in Greenwald where August operates a blacksmith shop; Fred, lives in Montana; Catherine, is deceased.

William Hollenhorst Sr. was a teamster, he worked for Bob Graham and Mr. Clark hauling stone. At this time he rented the Seberger House where he kept boarders and roomers for about two and one-half years. In 1891 he bought a farm in Mahew Lake. He retired in 1912 renting his farm to Emmel Rajkowski who has been operating this farm for the past twenty-four years.

Mrs. Anna (Berger) Hollenhorst died in 1912 and Mr. William Hollenhorst Sr. in 1915.
