To Mathias and Elizabeth Jensen ten children were born. Peter married Walberga Soms, they have five children. Henry married Thresia Soms and is employed at the Mathew Hall Lumber Company, they have eight children. John is living in Portland, Oregon. Lucy is married to Mike Goedert who is employed at the Great Northern Railway, they have two children. Leo is with a traveling carnival in Florida. Dora married Alois Franke, they have seven children. Joseph is deceased. Anna married John Sumbs and he is a stone cutter. Mathias Jr. married Emma Kiffler. Mathias Jr. is a barber and owns a shop on Seventh Avenue North in Saint Cloud. Nicholas married Carola Kiffler.

Mathias Jensen Sr. died in 1912. Mrs. Elizabeth Jensen moved into Saint Cloud in 1914. She bought a home on Tenth Avenue North, where she lived until her death in 1914.
