JERNBERG, AUGUST JUNIOR

August Jernberg was born August 10, 1858, in Degerfors, Sweden, son of Mr. and Mrs. August Jernberg Senior. August Junior was their eldest child. August Junior attended school until he reached about the fifth grade. He then accepted employment in a mine as a blacksmith's helper.

In 1879 August Junior was married to Johanna Peterson in Degerfors, Sweden. Three years later in 1881, August Junior and Johanna (Peterson) Jernberg came to the United States. Upon their arrival in this country they came directly to Saint Cloud. Here August followed his trade of blacksmith, working in various granite quarries until 1922, when he returned to Sweden.

August and Johanna (Peterson) Jernberg were the parents of four children: Helen, Levi, Helmer and Lillian. Helen is the wife of Warren Wire they live in Los Angeles, California. Levi married Elizabeth Schmitt. Levi died at the age of thirty-three in St. Cloud, leaving his wife and one son Walter F. Helmer lives in Winnipeg, Canada. Lillian is the wife of Napoleon Lampkin they live at Procter, Minnesota.

August Jernberg Junior died March 15, 1928, in Sweden. Johanna (Peterson) Jernberg died January 28, 1923, she is buried in North Star Cemetery St. Cloud.
