JUENEMANN, PETER

Peter Juenemann was born August 15, 1873 in St. Cloud. Nick Juenemann, his father was born in Germany, coming to this country and settling on the present site in 1854.

Peter was baptized in St. Mary's Church and attended the school on the Luxemburg road. His first teachers were Edward Doerner and Jake Hohman. Mr. Hohman lives in Waite Park at present.

Mr. Juenemann has been in the farming and truck farming business most of his life on the land his father homesteaded in 1854.

September 11, 1895 he was married to Theresa Blissenbach a native of Germany. Father Gregory of St. Mary's Church performed the wedding ceremony.

His father was the first person to be killed in the tornado of April 14, 1886, which hit St. Cloud and Sauk Rapids.

Peter and his wife had twelve children, nine are living, they are: Alfred, Norbert, George, Leonard, Leo, Herman, Ralph, boys and Angeline and Lyola girls. They have ten grand children.

When Mr. Juenemann was a boy the present home was on a prairie with no houses near by.

Nick Juenemann was one of the first settlers in Stearns County coming in 1854 about the same time as the Edelbrocks, John Wilson, and other early pioneers.

Nick was a farmer and his sons and grandsons have continued in his choosen occupation for the past eighty-three years.
