KINSELLA, ROBERT B.

Robert B. Kinsella was born in County Carlo, Ireland on December 2, 1840. He came to Canada with his parents in May, 1847 locating in the county of Renfrew. In 1868 the family moved to Pierce County, Wisconsin. He was married to Catherine Power, October 1879 and located at Red Wing, Minnesota, where he lived until 1885 when he moved to Raymond township, Stearns County, where he settled on a farm.

Four children were born to Robert and Catherine Kinsella: John E. born December 28, 1881 at Red Wing, Minnesota; James C. was born December 19, 1891, Edward was born June 3, 1899, Anna (Mrs. Frank Rousslange; Robert who died in infancy.

Robert B. Kinsella died April 16, 1924. He was a devout Catholic and was buried in St. Paul's cemetery Sauk Centre.
