LENGER, ANTHONY

Anthony Lenger a native of Jefferson, Wisconsin, was born January 27, 1853, a son of Christian and Elizabeth Lenger who were natives of Trier, Germany. They came to America in the 1840's and settled in Jefferson, Wisconsin.

Anthony Lenger attended the country school in Jefferson for a few years, and when the family moved to Minnesota and settled on a farm near Richmond, in Stearns County he attended the country school there. After completing his school years Anthony Lenger worked on his father's farm for several years, and then started farming for himself in Saint Martin township. This farm Anthony operated a number of years and then he traded the farm for a refreshment business in Saint Martin, Minnesota. He operated this business for eight years then he moved to Rockville, Minnesota, where he established another refreshment business. In 1895 Anthony Lenger died at the age of forty-two.

Anthony Lenger was married on November 13, 1877 in the Catholic Church of Saint Martin to Anna Haehn who was a daughter of Peter and Anna Marie (Schneider) Haehn.

Peter and Anna Marie (Schneider) Haehn were natives of the Rhineland Germany who came to America as small children with their parents. After their marriage they came to Stearns County, Minnesota and settled on a homestead in Saint Martin township described as North one-fourth of Section thirty-five, Township one hundred and twenty-four, North Range thirty-two, West one hundred and sixty acres. On this homestead Anna Haehn was born July 20, 1861. As there was no church in Saint Martin her parents drove to Richmond, Minnesota to have her baptized.

To Anthony and Anna (Haehn) Lenger were born the following children: Elizabeth was born in 1878 and died in infancy; Mary, Mrs. John Trossen of Saint Cloud, Minnesota was born November 8, 1879; Catherine, Mrs. John

Gillis of Saint Cloud was born March 9, 1882; Margaret, was born January 27, 1884, died June 28, 1932, she was Mrs. John Hengel; Mathias of Saint Cloud, Minnesota was born May 10, 1886; Anthony was born February 19, 1888 and died January 16, 1892; Alyois P. at home, was born September 14, 1891; Elizabeth, Mrs. Glen Rice of Minneapolis, was born May 31, 1894.

Mrs. Anna Lenger lives with her son, Alyois P. Lenger on Tenth Avenue North.
