LIETCH, HENRY S.

Henry S. Lietch was born in St. Cloud March 3, 1863, the son of Robert and Anna (Martin) Lietch of Ireland. Robert Lietch, the father of Henry, came from Ireland in a sailing vessel. He came to St. Cloud, Minnesota, where he followed no particular trade but managed a fair living. He bought a home on Fifth Avenue and First Street North which burned in 1865, he then bought two lots on Eighth Avenue South on which he built a home which still belongs to Henry Lietch, the only son of Robert, and is known as the Lietch homestead.

During the Civil War, in 1862, Robert Lietch drove a stage coach between East St. Cloud and Fort Abercrombie, at this time his son, Henry S. Lietch, was born.

Henry Lietch attended the Saint Mary's school located where the 1936 Post Office now stands. There were between twenty and thirty pupils at this school when he attended, later he attended the Union School.

Henry Lietch married Anna Henry of Wisconsin. Anna Henry is of French descent, her parents coming from France.

Mr. and Mrs. Henry, parents of Anna, were married in New York where they stayed for a short time. From New York they moved to Wisconsin, and when Anna was seventeen years old they moved to St. Cloud where she was married to Henry Lietch. Henry and Anna (Henry) Lietch have five children: Cora and Loretta, who are staying home; Luella, married C. R. Andrews, they have two children and live in La Port, Minnesota; Florence (Lietch) Hoover, living at Cedar Rapids; Robert Lietch; and Edna (deceased).

Henry Lietch was a Great Northern Agent for forty-seven years, starting in Melrose in 1882 then working at Freeport, Avon and Fergus Falls division, he retired from active service in 1929.
