Peter Loso, born in Prussia, February 25, 1824, died in St. Joseph, Stearns county, Minnesota, October 27, 1877. He was the first white settler there, 1854; was one of the townsite proprietors and owned flour and lumber mills. After 1867 he was proprietor of a hotel in St. Joseph.
