LOWRY, SYLVANUS B.

File No. B-825

Sylvanus B. Lowry, established a trading post at Brockway, Stearns county, Minnesota, in early times, was adjutant general of Minnesota territory, 1853; removed to St. Cloud in 1853, and died there in 1861. He surveyed and platted the village of Arcadia, adjoining St. Cloud known afterward as Lowry's Addition.
