MOLINE, CARL J.

Carl J. Moline was born January 29, 1889 in Varmland, Sweden, the son of Carl and Anna (Johnson) Moline.

Carl attended school in Sweden until he was fourteen years of age when he secured employment on a ocean vessel as the captain's steward. Carl was employed on this boat until he was nineteen years old. At that age he came to America coming directly to Tuhlen, Illinois, where an uncle resided.

In Tuhlen, Illinois Carl learned the trade of stone cutter. In 1910 Carl came to Melrose, Stearns County, Minnesota, where he was employed in the granite sheds. In 1919 Carl Moline came to Saint Cloud, Minnesota where he secured employment in the Royal Granite Company's plant, where he has since been employed. At present he is receiver of this company.

Carl J. Moline was married to Bertha Schwanke daughter of William and Mary (Kind) Schwanke of Melrose, Minnesota, on March 31, 1912.

Carl and Bertha (Schwanke) Moline are the parents of two children, Arvid and Iona, both of whom make their home with their parents of St. Cloud, Minnesota.
