NAGUSCHEWSKI, JULIUS R.

Julius Naguschewski was born in East Prussia, Germany June 8, 1854. He attended school in Prussia and then became a farm laborer for his father. During his work for his father he secured a very extensive knowledge of farming and decided to making that his life work.

About 1870 Julius came to America and secured a job in Illinois. In that state he met and married Mary Gallenbeck at the town of Decatur on February 21, 1894.

Mary (Gallenbeck) Naguschewski was born in East Prussia December 24, 1856 daughter of Michael and Beckert Gallenbeck. She attended school in Prussia and then stayed with her parents. At the age of 24 she came to America and went to Decatur, Illinois where she worked until her marriage.

After his marriage to Mary Gallenbeck, Julius purchased a farm in Illinois and lived there for several years. He then moved to Minnesota and purchased a farm near St. Cloud. Here Julius farmed almost continuously until his retirement into the city of St. Cloud. He now lives with his wife at 321-2nd Ave. N. E. St. Cloud, Minn.

To Julius and Mary (Gallenbeck) Naguschewski were born six children two deceased, the living are - Olga, Tillie, Augusta and Mary. There are also eight grandchildren.
