Nils Nilson, known as "Cap" to his friends, was born on October 18, 1843 in Lund, Skone, Sweden.

He migrated to America and settled in Albert Lea, Minnesota.

In 1893, Nils married Dorothe C. Larson.

Before his death, Nils Nilson lived with his daughter, Mrs. Even Ponerud of Brooten.

Nils Nilson died on February 2, 1929. He is buried in Brooten.
