PANGBURN, WILLIAM

William Pangburn was born in New Scotland, New York, May 12, 1836. William is the son of David D. and Polly (Houck) Pangburn. William lived in New York until the out break of the Civil War when he enlisted, and was in the service throughout the conflict, fourteen months of which he was confined in a southern prison. He was discharged at Madison, Wisconsin after which he came west, reaching Sauk Centre May 12, 1865.

William Pangburn married Ella Elizabeth Barnard November 7, 1866. They have seven children: Minnie; Frank T.; Josie; Maude; Jessie; Ralph; and Leon.

William Pangburn took a homestead in Sauk Centre township, broke the land, erected suitable buildings, and carried on general farming until 1879, when he moved to the city.

He was a member of the city council for about eighteen years, he was treasurer of Palmer Post, No. 40 G. A. R. and a member of I. O. O. F.

William Pangburn died April 12, 1915 and is buried at Sauk Centre. He was a member of the Methodist Church.
