PARKER, CLARENCE W.

Clarence W. Parker was born on May 2, 1859 in St. Charles, Illinois. He was the son of Henry and Jane S. Parker.

Clarence Parker married Nellie McCune at Letcher, South Dakota, on January 1, 1883.

Clarence W. and Nellie (McCune) Parker came to Sauk Centre in 1892 from South Dakota. They settled in Ashley township on a farm. He was the town clerk there for many years.

In 1916, they left Sauk Centre and went to Sutherlin, Oregon, where they made their home until the death of Clarence Parker.

Clarence W. and Nellie (McCune) Parker had four sons and two daughters. They are: Ray H. of Sutherlin, Oregon; C. Fenton of Oregon City, Oregon; William M. of Minneapolis; Charles H. of Sutherlin, Oregon; Mrs. C. Wilson Swift of Ashley township, Minnesota, and Mrs. G. Herbert Swift of Salem, Oregon.

Clarence W. Parker died on June 26, 1920. He was brought to Sauk Centre for burial. He is buried in Greenwood Cemetery.
